

Veggie-Forward Pocket Pies

Del Monte Foods (delmonte.com), Walnut Creek, Calif., introduces plant-based Pocket Pies that deliver a full serving of veggies and 9 to 10 grams of protein per sandwich. Offered under the Veggieful brand, the microwaveable handheld snacks feature a better-for-you cauliflower crust, 100% real cheese and no artificial flavors or preservatives. Available flavors include Broccoli Potato Cheddar, Spinach Artichoke Parmesan, Plant-Based Philly Cheesesteak, and Rosemary Garlic Plant-Based Chicken. Packed eight to a case, each 8-ounce package contains two pocket pies. SRP is \$3.99.



new STÖK Fueled brand, ready-to-drink Unsweet Cold Brew Coffee delivers 10 grams of protein, 5 grams of MCT oil, fat from butter and 0 grams of added sugar per serving. STÖK Fueled Creamers (in Original, Vanilla and Unsweet flavors) offer 5 grams of protein, 5 grams of MCT oil, real butter

and half the sugar of typical coffee creamers (the Unsweet variety contains zero added sugar). The coffee comes in 48-ounce multi-serve bottles, while the creamers are offered in 16-ounce bottles. SRPs are \$5.49 and \$3.99, respectively.



Plant-Based Seafood

Heath, Ohio-based Good Catch (goodcatchfoods.com) expands its collection of plant-based seafood with a trio of frozen entrees and appetizers featuring real seafood taste and texture. Made with a six-plant protein blend, the non-GMO, vegan lineup includes skillet-ready New England Style Plant-Based Crab Cakes (eight per package), Thai Style Plant-Based Fish Cakes (four per package) and Classic Style Plant-Based Fish Burger (two per package). All three offer at least 20 grams of protein and 90mg of DHA per serving. Packed six to a case, each 8-ounce package is expected to retail for around \$5.99.



Plant-Based Proteins

Planterra Foods, Lafayette, Colo., debuts a new plant-based meat alternative made with a proprietary blend of iron-rich pea and rice protein fermented by shiitake mushrooms (for easy digestibility). Offered under the new OZO brand (ozofoods.com), the soy-free, non-GMO collection includes Burgers, Ground,



Mexican-Seasoned Ground and Italian-Style Meatballs, all excellent sources of protein (up to 22 grams per serving). The cholesterol-free products contain less fat and saturated fat and fewer calories than 80%

Dairy- and Gluten-Free Novelties

Richmond, Utah-based Casper's Ice Cream adds Non GMO Project-verified, dairy- and gluten-free frozen novelties to its Jolly Llama (thejollyllama.com) collection. Described as a category first, the coconut cream-based, vegan lineup includes Premium Vanilla and Cool Mint Chocolate Chip Sandwiches (in four-count, 11-ounce packages) and Fudge Sundae and Caramel Chocolate Chip Cones (in three-count 10.5-ounce packages). Packed eight to a case, they each carry a \$4.99 SRP.

Billed as a category first, Mamma Chia Organic Chiamilk delivers essential Omega-3s, MCT, more calcium than traditional milk and zero grams of sugar. Free of lactose, soy and gluten, the 100% vegan, Non GMO Project-verified milk substitute comes in two varieties, Unsweetened Original and Unsweetened Vanilla, both with 0 grams of sugar and 60 to 70 calories per serving. Packed six to a case, each 28-ounce bottle is expected to retail for around \$4.99.
