There's no type of dog that needs or enjoys a bully stick more than a teething puppy. These extra-thin baby bully sticks are great for dogs with small jaws and/or puppies. They're manageable, but will still keep them occupied and entertained for long periods of time.

What to look for when shopping for bully sticks

Bully sticks are popular with dog owners and dogs alike because they can keep your pup entertained and engaged for hours. For puppies, this is particularly helpful, especially given their razor sharp teeth and tendency to chew anything but toys or treats.

Bully sticks help pups get some of their energy out while being more digestible than <u>rawhide</u> <u>chews</u>, which can be more of a choking hazard and can often contain more chemicals, according to the American Kennel Club.

As Dr. Abel Gonzalez, veterinarian and clinical director at <u>Dutch</u>, explains, when shopping for bully sticks, it's especially crucial to look at ingredients. Dr. Gonzalez suggests single-ingredient options that don't include preservatives, flavors, or colors.

"The source of the bully stick is also important," Dr. Gonzalez adds. "Opt for those made from grass-fed, free-range cattle to ensure higher nutritional value."

- ✓ **Ingredients:** Knowing your dogs allergies and dietary requirements is incredibly important before purchasing a bully stick. As an article on the American Kennel Club's website explains, <u>bully sticks can be a great protein alternative</u> for dogs with allergies to other types of proteins.
- ✓ **Nutritional value:** "Before buying bully sticks, it's good to know that they are a high-protein, low-fat chew option made from dried beef pizzle," Dr. Gonzalez says. "However, they can be high in calories, so moderation is key, especially for dogs on a weight management plan."
- ✓ **Size.** Every type of dog is a different type of chewer, and there are a variety of sizes and styles of bully sticks to reflect those differences. In other words, giving your dog the biggest bully stick imaginable if they don't like to chew that much might not make sense. "

For smaller dogs or puppies, thinner and shorter bully sticks are generally more appropriate," Dr. Gonzalez explains. "These are easier for them to manage and less likely to pose a choking hazard. For medium-sized dogs, a medium-thickness stick of about six to nine inches long usually works well. Larger dogs or aggressive chewers may benefit from thicker and longer bully sticks that are 12 inches or more. These not only last longer but also provide a good workout for the jaw muscles."

✓ **Age:** Bully sticks are great for puppies and older dogs alike. As the American Kennel Club explains, if your <u>dog can chew hard treats</u> and food, then they can handle bully sticks, too.

FAQs

- What is a bully stick made of? It's not exactly a pleasant revelation, but <u>bully sticks are</u> made out <u>bulls</u> specifically, the bull pizzle, or penis.
- What are the benefits of a bully stick? Bully sticks are <u>high in protein</u> and a great source of amino acids, according to the American Kennel Club. They also are more easily digestible than other alternatives, and don't splinter upon chewing. Because they're such a tough piece of muscle, they can keep even the most aggressive chewers entertained for hours.
- **Do vets recommend bully sticks?** Yes, the <u>American Kennel Club recommends bully sticks</u> as a safe, healthy, and engaging treat for dogs.
- Are bully sticks safe? As Dr. Gonzalez cautions, it's always crucial to supervise your pet while they're enjoying their bully stick to ensure they don't break off large pieces that could be swallowed whole, as this could pose a choking risk. "Remember, each dog is unique," Dr.

Gonzalez says. "So it may take some trial and error to find the bully stick size that's just right for your furry friend."
